Welcome to the exciting world of American Literature! Because you are an honors level student, you are expected to immerse yourself this summer in the world of one

of America's greatest authors, Ernest Hemingway. Your assignment is to read the novel The Sun Also Rises and prepare for the first few weeks of class, which will

include a test on the novel (day three of class), a project, and several Socratic

discussions. You will also be expected to write an AP essay (week two).

If you can purchase the actual novel via Amazon or Barnes and Noble, that would

be helpful for annotation purposes. If you would rather read from your phone or

another electronic device, feel free to purchase a kindle app or *i*book copy. To save

money, feel free to read the pdf at gutenberg or check out the novel from a local

library.
