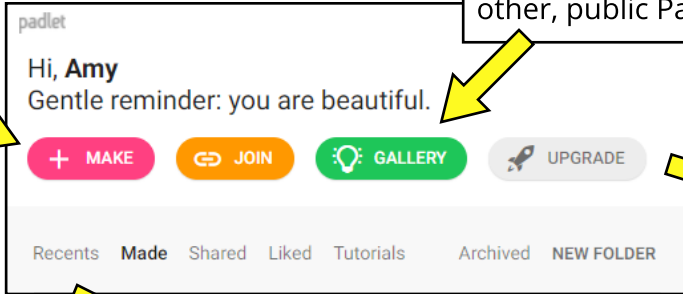

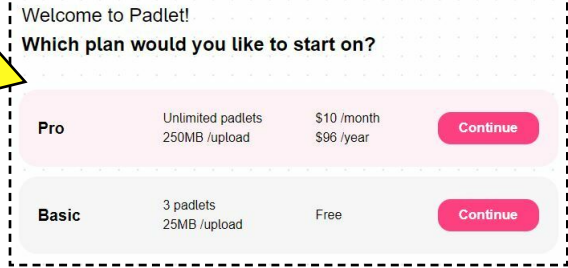
In the Dashboard:

Click on "Make" to start a new Padlet.

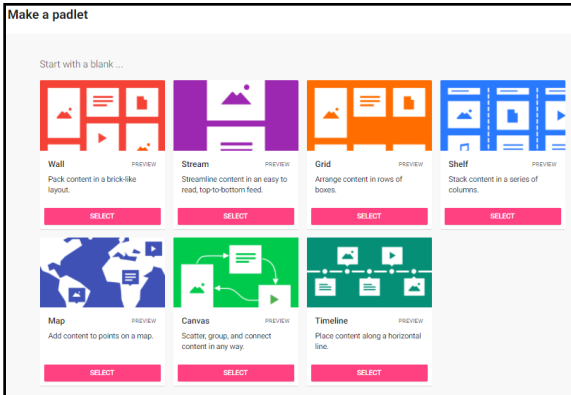


These are your Padlets.

Creating a Padlet

Click on "Make" to start a new Padlet & click "Select" under the template you want to use.



Wall

Wall packs content in a brick-like layout. It is ideal for moodboards, pinboards, bookmarking, photo albums, and file sharing where the order of items is not that important but you need something visual.

Canvas

Our most flexible format, canvas allows you to put content anywhere, resize it, connect it to other content on the page. It is ideal for brainstorming, mind maps, org charts, and flowcharts.

Stream

Stream puts content in top-to-bottom or bottom-to-top order. It is ideal for blog posts, websites, video playlists, lessons, assignments, reports, or pretty much anything you'd traditionally use Microsoft Word for.

Grid

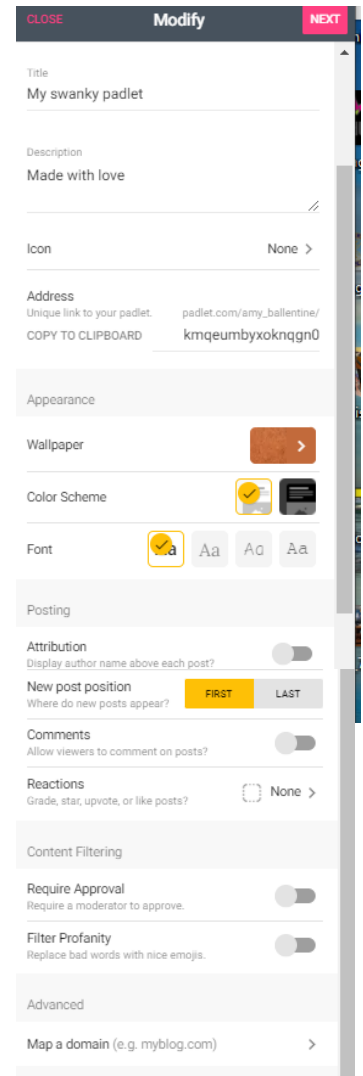
Grid arranges your content in rows of boxes. It is ideal for digital storytelling, storyboarding, noticeboards, or anything else where you want to put content visually and the order is important.

Settings Under the Gear Icon

You will have lots of options for settings on the right side of the screen.

Much of this is fairly intuitive.

- You can chose the name for your website link.
- For your background / wallpaper, you can chose colors, gradients, patterns, and pictures.
- Choosing "Attribution" should list names with a person's comments, but only if they have a Padlet account.
- "Reactions" let viewers respond with likes, thumbs up/down, and stars.
- Click "Requires Approval" to review viewer comments prior to posting.

Sharing with Others

You can share in several ways:

- Google Classroom
- Links
- Click "Requires Approval" to review viewer comments prior to posting.
- When you "invite people," type in an email, and decide whether they can read, write, edit, or administer the Padlet
- Export student work with QR codes & hold a gallery walk

Under the "Share" tab you can change your privacy settings.

Private
Keep the padlet hidden from the public. Even if someone manages to get to it, they should not be able to access it.

Password
Keep the padlet hidden from the public. If I choose to share it with someone, they should require a password to access it.

Members only
Keep the padlet hidden from the public. Only logged in users can access this padlet.

Secret
Keep the padlet hidden from the public. If I choose to share it with someone, they should be able to access it.

Public
Let the whole world see this padlet. Put it on my profile.

Hints & Tips

There is NO auto-save. Be sure to click the pink "Save" button in settings to save your changes .

Everyone sees everyone's responses, but responses are anonymous.

You can change formats in the middle of your activity / post. Be careful - you may lose formatting by doing this (ex: Canvas arrows).

Different templates provide different posting options in settings - ex: Wall = "new post first." To tell which template you are in go to "Change format." The one you are in will NOT be listed.

There are several different choices for posting: double click, drag/drop, click on pink "+" in bottom right.

To search in the "Gallery," use command+Find.

When posting, click on the orange buttons to search the web & import directly.
