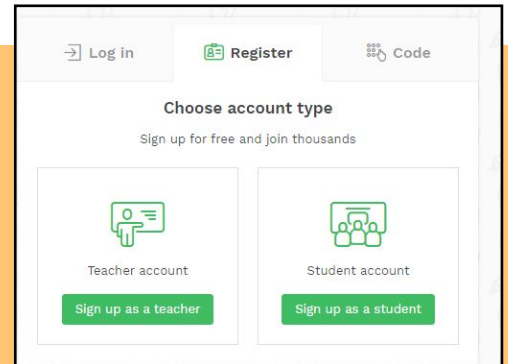


General Information

Adding students into an activity -- it can be done in two ways:

They will go to the web address "gospiral.ac" and click "Register."

- ▶ To join through Google Classroom - choose "Google" in the bottom left
- ▶ To join as a "guest," enter the teacher code



Navigating these on-line tools, teachers and students go back and forth to move the program forward.

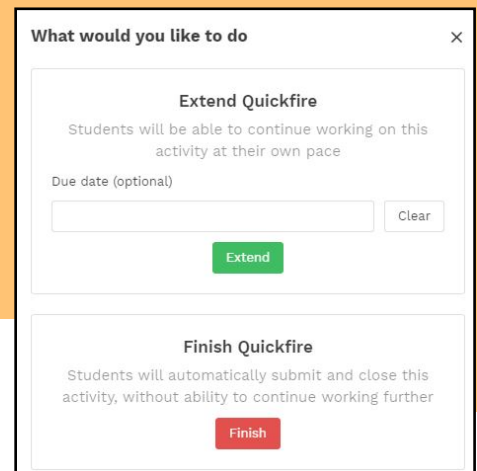
- Students join
- Teachers open the activity and click "Go"
- Students click "Start" and then they show-up in the teacher's list
- As students answer questions, their answers appear on the teacher's screen for scoring

Sharing with other teachers:

- Click on the "share" icon and type in an email address.
- The teacher receiving the activity has to click on "Access Shared Activity" for it to show up in their dashboard.
- Changes made to the shared copy do not change the original.

Providing Extended Time:

- When a class activity is completed, teachers can put in a future due date to allow students who need extended time.

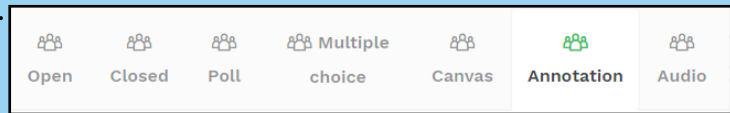
Students' scores can be viewed in several ways:

1. They show at the end of each activity.
2. Go to "Classes" - click on "Activities" - click "Review" next to the activity to see scores.
3. View scores by question, by student, or as a overall grade.

Quickfire

Carry out a quickfire formative assessment to see what the whole class is thinking

- ▶ Teachers ask assessment questions -- verbally (Quickfire Lite) or written (Quickfire)
- ▶ Teachers "Launch" the activity.
- ▶ Students click on "Start"
- ▶ Teachers click on "Go"
- ▶ Students type in answers and click "Submit"
- ▶ Teacher clicks "Correct" or "Improve"
- ▶ Students see -- a star for a correct answer OR "you have been asked to improve your answer" for a wrong answer.
- ▶ Students can change their answers and resubmit



For Quickfire - Teachers create questions ahead of time. Choose "Save - Teach" then choose the class to assign it to.

Clip

Turn any public video into a live chat with questions and quizzes

Videos are added from YouTube into a screen where teachers add questions to assess student understanding.

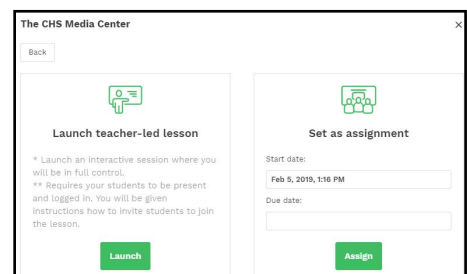
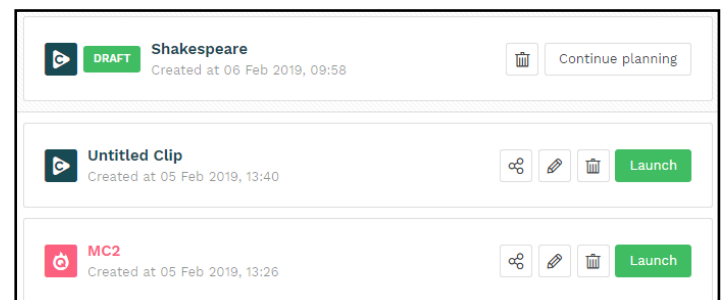
- ▶ Students watch the chosen video, type in answers, and click "submit"

The video is on the classroom screen if it is "Teacher-Led." If students are working independently ("Student-Led") then the video is on their screens.

The questions and answers follow the same format as in Quickfire.

Helpful Hints:

1. Clicking on the edit pencil automatically creates a draft--but not a copy--of the activity.
2. The "Teacher-Led" / "Student-Led" button dictates who is running the activity.
"Teacher-Led" = teacher controls the video or the pace of the questions
"Student-Led" = students work at their own pace
3. Lessons can be run on the spot OR scheduled for the future.



4 Options for Spiral.ac:

- **Quickfire:** Carry out a quickfire formative assessment to see what the whole class is thinking.
- **Discuss:** Create interactive presentations to spark creativity in class.
- **Team Up:** Student teams can create and share collaborative presentations from linked devices.
- **Clip:** Turn any public video into a live chat with questions and quizzes.

In the top right

- "Home" (Dashboard) - Goes to teacher created activities
- "Classes" - Add in a Google Classroom for upcoming activities
- "Students" - Add students individually into activities
